LECTURE & PROGRAM ON JOHN HONEYMAN - SUNDAY, MARCH 12th

George W. (Tres) Arnett, III to Speak on John Honeyman at Lamington Presbyterian Church

George W. (Tres) Arnett, III will be the guest speaker at the Society's Meeting on Sunday, March 12 at 1 PM at the <u>Lamington Presbyterian Church 355 Lamington Road in</u> <u>Bedminster Township</u>. Please note this is the 2nd Sunday of March, not our normal 3rd Sunday of the month and at a special location. We will be meeting in the Sanctuary at the Church followed by refreshments in the Gladish Room.

A former resident of Tewksbury and Elder at the Lamington Presbyterian Church, Tres is an amateur historian and former Trustee of the New Jersey Historical Society. Born in Trenton and growing up in the Griggstown area, he always heard about John Honeyman, the alleged spy who provided information to George Washington about the arrangement of Hessian forces at Trenton. Honeyman, also a resident of Griggstown and Bedminster, was stationed at Trenton when the British occupied New Jersey after the loss of New York by the Revolutionary forces. His information helped Washington win the Battle of Trenton, December 1776. Honeyman is buried in the cemetery across the street from the Lamington Church.

Arnett narrated a program about Honeyman entitled "Fox Nation Untold: Patriot Revealed", Season 3, Episode 2. The story has been considered both "myth" and "true". Arnett will examine the facts and present the case. He and his wife now live in Florida.

MANSION IN MAY – SPECIAL PRESENTATION – SUNDAY, APRIL 23

Author and historian, W. Barry Thomson, will present an illustrated talk on Three Fields, the site of the 20th Mansion in May Designer Showhouse and Gardens presented by the Women's Association for Morristown Medical Center, for the Tewksbury Historical Society on Sunday, April 23 at 1:30 pm at the Zion Lutheran Christian Education Building 18 Miller Avenue in Oldwick. The lecture is free and open to the public and no pre-registration is required.

Three Fields, designed and built between 1928 and 1930, is a 9,000 square foot stone, brick and tile-roofed French manor style home located in the Borough of Mendham, NJ. The mansion was designed by New York architect Greville Rickard for Benjamin Duncan Mosser and his wife, the former Florence Willets Mosford.

Barry's illustrated talk will cover the history and design of the Three Fields estate and discuss the first two families that lived there, the Mossers, who built the house, and Andrew and Dorothea Fletcher, who purchased the estate in 1949 and who were such generous benefactors to Mendham. The talk will also describe the design of Three Fields by architect Greville Rickard and the original landscape architect, Robert Ludlow Fowler Jr.
